FISCAL COURT REGULAR MEETING: Woodford County Courthouse
Tuesday, March 10, 2026, at 5:30 p.m.

PRESIDING: James Kay, Woodford County Judge/Executive

PRESENT: Magistrates Liles Taylor, John Gentry, Darrell Varner, Kelly Carl, William Downey,
Larry Blackford, Mary Ann Gill, and Jackie Brown

Judge/Executive Kay opened with a moment of silence in memory and honor of John Owen Range,
Terry Withers and Squire Mary Ann Gill's mother, Rita Thaman.

GOOD OF THE COUNTY

Representatives from CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) of Lexington presented an overview of their program and requested \$20,000 in funding for the upcoming fiscal year. CASA serves abused and neglected children in seven counties, including Woodford County, and reported that 23 volunteers served 52 local children in 2025. The request had previously been received and recommended for inclusion in the upcoming budget.

CASA also recognized local volunteers through the Serve Kentucky Awards for contributing over 100 hours of service in 2025. Sally Snider was present to receive recognition, and Aaron Hall was also honored but unable to attend. The court expressed appreciation for the work of CASA and its volunteers in supporting children in the community.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Judge/Executive Kay called for any additions, corrections, or amendments to the minutes for the Regular Meeting of February 24, 2026. Hearing none, these minutes stood approved as presented.

EDA UPDATE – YOKOHAMA PROJECT

The court received an update on the proposed economic development project involving the former Yokohama facility. It was reported that the county was awarded a \$2 million Kentucky Product Development Initiative (KPDI) grant to assist with the \$8.5 million purchase of the property, along with a \$100,000 opportunity grant from Kentucky Utilities to help cover due diligence costs and match requirements.

Due to the KPDI grant timeline, the project schedule has accelerated, requiring the property purchase to occur before June 30. The city and county are working with First Kentucky Securities on bonding for the acquisition, and both the Versailles City Council and Fiscal Court are expected to consider an interlocal agreement related to the bonding process.

It was also noted that the property may be marketed for sale prior to closing to help identify a future employer. The project aims to attract new manufacturing jobs, protect the industrial site for appropriate use, and replace occupational tax revenue lost as the Yokohama facility winds down operations. The Fiscal Court will consider the interlocal agreement for the bonding process at the March 24 meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

The Personnel Committee met prior to the Regular Meeting of March 10, 2026, with all members in attendance. The committee is currently interviewing candidates for the Road Supervisor position following the retirement of Bo Wilson. Screening interviews have been completed, and the committee will meet as a Committee of the Whole on Monday, March 16 at 1:00 p.m. to review candidates and conduct interviews. The court may also consider designating an interim department head and determining the term or tenure of the appointment. The Personnel Committee also recommended approval of the presented Personnel Order.

Personnel Order

1. A motion was made by John Gentry and seconded by Kelly Carl to approve the personnel order as presented. **(Attachment)**

Immediately following the Personnel Committee meeting, the Budget and Finance Committee met with all members in attendance. The committee continued discussion of the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 budget and received a draft of the EMS budget, with a draft of the Recycling/Solid Waste budget forthcoming.

The committee also recommended approval of the Emergency Needs Assistance resolution, which allocates funding to several local organizations, including Bluegrass Community Action Partnership, the Woodford Foundation, United Way of the Bluegrass, the Woodford County Food Pantry, the Salvation Army, and The Station, to support community assistance programs.

The committee also considered the ambulance bid request beginning fiscal year 2025-2026, however it may not be expended and will be budgeted for fiscal year 2026-2027, upon recommendation of the EMS Director. The EMS Director also presented the new proposed fee rates for the new 911 billing service.

The committee also discussed a request from the Steele Cemetery for reimbursement of half of the \$6,000 cost for tree and landscape services, which had been presented to the Cemetery Preservation Board. Additional information will be obtained from the board regarding the request.

The committee also reviewed vehicle allocations for the Woodford County Road Department, noting that several vehicles ordered in prior budgets, dating back to 2023, may soon be arriving for purchase.

The committee authorized restarting the Young and New Farmer Grant Program for the current budget cycle and directed that the program be advertised. The court also agreed to prioritize new applicants first, as recommended by Squire Darrell Varner.

The committee also discussed the Emergency Management grant agreement, updates on the EWP buyout program, and the renewal of Microsoft licensing.

Resolution 2026-05 Emergency Needs Funding

County Clerk – Digitization Quote for Grant Application

Emergency Management Director, Drew Chandler - Emergency Management Director Drew Chandler reported that the county was awarded a \$2,761,744 grant through the Government Resources Accelerating Need Transformation (GRANT) Program from the Kentucky Cabinet for Economic Development. The funding will help offset the local match required for the USDA Emergency

Watershed Protection (EWP) buyout program related to recent flood events. With the grant and other federal funding, the county's net cost for the approximately \$12 million project is expected to be about 5% of the total cost. The Fiscal Court approved the grant agreement unanimously.

Director Chandler also provided an update on the EWP buyout process, noting that title opinions have been requested, appraisals are underway, and environmental assessments are being initiated. The court was asked to approve an agreement with Thunderbird Environmental to conduct the required environmental reviews as part of the property acquisition process.

GRANT Grant Agreement

12. 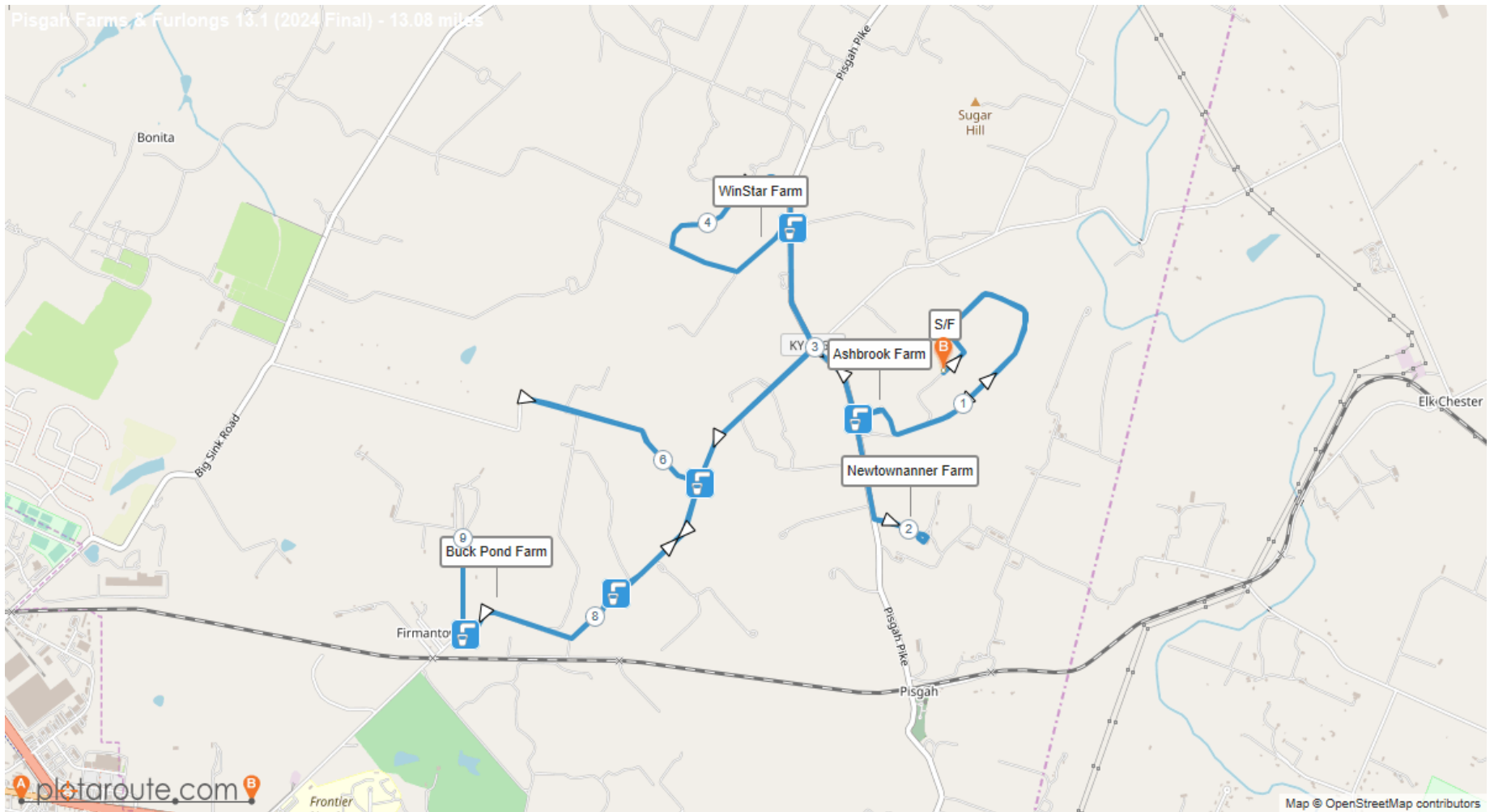





ORDINANCE NO. 2025-20

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FORMAL ADOPTION OF
A CERTAIN NEW PUBLIC ROAD INTO THE
WOODFORD COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, historically, the Woodford County Fiscal Court has authorized the Woodford County Road Department, at the direction of the Woodford County Road Engineer or Road Supervisor, to maintain certain public roads as county roads; and

WHEREAS, these roads should be formally adopted into the Woodford County Road system for such work to take place; and

WHEREAS, the Woodford County Fiscal Court has previously formally declared and adopted a county road system; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary and in the best interest of the county to also adopt the following described road into the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Woodford, Commonwealth of Kentucky, as follows:

1. That the following described road is now ripe for acceptance, and is hereby incorporated into the Woodford County Road System as a county road:

ROAD NAME	LENGTH	WIDTH	RIGHT-OF-WAY	DESCRIPTION
Larland Lane	2,415 feet (0.457 miles)	22.75 feet	50 feet	From Carpenter Pike to the end of the cul-de-sac and back to Carpenter Pike

2. The Woodford County Road Department, at the direction of the Woodford County Road Engineer or Road Supervisor, shall maintain this county road as needs and standards dictate, and erect any attendant signage.

Introduced and given first reading at a regular meeting of the Woodford County Fiscal Court on February 24, 2026, and fully adopted after the second reading at the regular session of the Woodford Fiscal Court on March 24, 2026. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to law.
